

Barbara Dulinsky Vietnam Narrative

Master Sergeant Barbara J. Dulinsky was the first female Marine to serve in the Republic of Vietnam. She arrived in Saigon on March 18th, 1967 with orders to the Military Assistance Command, Vietnam (USMACV). Master Sergeant Dulinsky was assigned to the J3, combat operations center, working as the Top Secret Control Officer/Custodian of Classified Documents. She remained in this billet until April 8th, 1968 when she was detached with orders to the Marine Corps Finance Center in Kansas City, Missouri.

The following 32 pages contain a typewritten narrative of Master Sergeant Dulinsky's experiences in the Republic of Vietnam. The reader will note that there are many misspellings throughout the document. The following narrative is a copy of what is housed in the Alfred M. Gray Marine Corps Research Center in Quantico, VA.
